- A 50% minimum deposit is required when booking a workshop. Cancellation of any workshop classes, needs to be at least 10 days prior to commencement of class, cancellation within 10 days will incur loss of deposit. Any cancellation after commencement of classes, a full fee is applicable, as this effects other attendees who have already bought product to attend class program. Balance payable before commencement of first session. Once workshop has commenced no payments will be refunded.
- Unless otherwise stated, in any classes using sewing machines, it is assumed you have a working knowledge of your own machine and all the parts required for that class. Please check that you have the power cords when you pack.
- Times and dates of classes may be subject to change. All classes are offered in good faith. A minimum class size must be reached before any class can go ahead. Please check with the shop 7 days before the class is due to start. It is very important to us that you do not invest a lot of money in class supplies until we are sure that the class will go ahead.
