Balance payable before commencement of first session. Once workshop has commenced no payments will be refunded.
- Unless otherwise stated, in any classes using sewing machines, it is assumed you
 have a working knowledge of your own machine and all the parts required for that
 class. Please check that you have the power cords when you pack.
- Times and dates of classes may be subject to change. All classes are offered in good faith. A minimum class size must be reached before any class can go ahead. Please check with the shop 7 days before the class is due to start. It is very important to us that you do not invest a lot of money in class supplies until we are sure that the class will go ahead.

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
