<p>DIZZY LIZZY Michele Higgins \$55 per class Plus fabric</p>	<p>Join this fun class! Made from half square triangles, 10 small squares and four rectangles of background fabric with a small white border and black binding. The finished size is 34" x 43" (can be made larger by simply making the half square triangles bigger), mine were from 6 1/2" squares.. no seams to match up anywhere on the quilt makes it very quick to put together! <i>Book early for this new class. Balance payable before commencement of first session. Once workshop has commenced no payments will be refunded.

- Unless otherwise stated, in any classes using sewing machines, it is assumed you have a working knowledge of your own machine and all the parts required for that class. Please check that you have the power cords when you pack.

- Times and dates of classes may be subject to change. All classes are offered in good faith. A minimum class size must be reached before any class can go ahead. Please check with the shop 7 days before the class is due to start. It is very important to us that you do not invest a lot of money in class supplies until we are sure that the class will go ahead.
